



INJURY REPORT FORMS

These are documents to be completed after a workplace injury. Contact Omaha National at 844-761-8400 to report the claim.

Employer's Report of Injury Web Form:

Employers are required to report workplace accidents and injuries to Omaha National and the Claims Division at the Arizona Industrial Commission within ten days after receiving notice of an accident. When an accident results in the death of a worker, the accident must be reported no later than the next business day following the death. Effective 8/31/2025, the Arizona Industrial Commission will no longer accept paper form submissions of the Employer's Report of Injury. You must use the web form version of the Employer's Report of Injury Form located on the Commission's website at <https://www.azica.gov/forms/employers-report-injury-form>. When submitted, the completed form will be emailed to you for your electronic signature. Once signed, the final form will be emailed to you for your records. Send a copy of the completed and signed form to Omaha National for our records.

ICA 2212 - Serious Event Reporting Form:

Arizona law also requires employers to report serious injuries and deaths to the Division of Occupational Safety and Health at the Arizona Industrial Commission. All work-related fatalities must be reported within eight hours following the incident and all work-related inpatient hospitalizations, all amputations, and all losses of an eye must be reported within twenty-four hours.

Incident, Supervisor, and Witness Reports:

When a workplace injury occurs, these forms may be used to gather information about an incident or injury. Copies should be sent to Omaha National at the same time you report the injury to us.
